

AWT Webinar: Reducing *Legionella* Risk with Confidence

Water treaters play an essential role in managing the risk of exposure to *Legionella*, the most prevalent disease causing waterborne microorganism in the U.S. today. *Legionella* exposure can lead to Legionnaires' disease, a potentially deadly form of pneumonia. During this webinar on March 14 at 11:00 am ET, Dr. Dan Broder, IDXX, will help attendees understand the basic science of *Legionella* bacteria in both building systems and in the environment, the guidelines focused on preventing Legionnaires' disease, and the latest developments in monitoring. In addition, strategies for talking comfortably with building owners and managers about *Legionella* and *Legionella pneumophila*, liability concerns, and concrete steps to ensure the effectiveness of water safety management plans will be discussed.
